- 11 Hold Reverend Sydney Samuel Lake and his family in your prayers

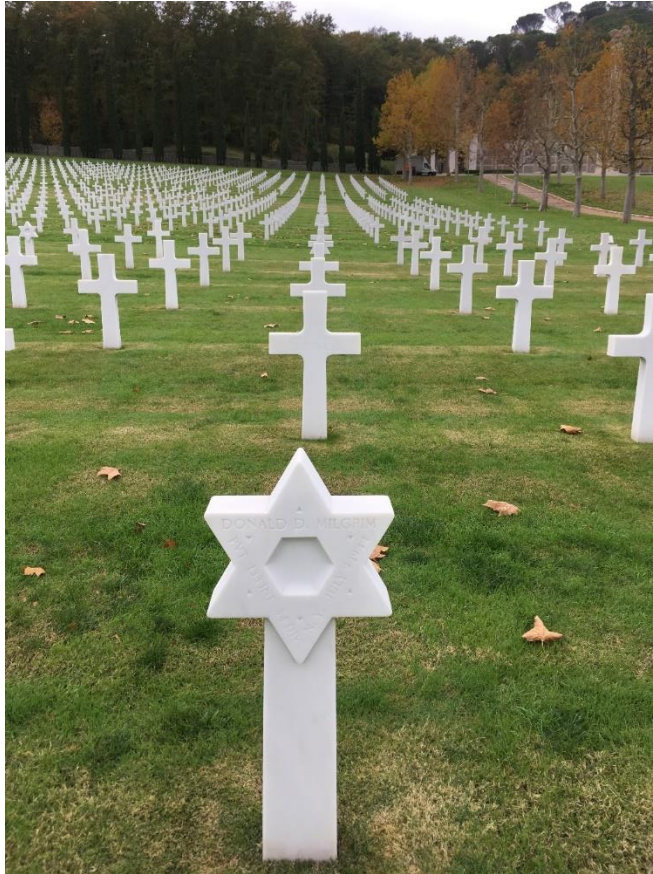
- 12** Pray for families as they enjoy the weekend together
