Posada



Last year I wrote and told you about how my family played host the Holy family in our home for a few days during Advent as part of the Woking Methodist church annual Posada.

The tradition of having the figures of Mary, Joseph and a donkey travelling from home to home during Advent is becoming more and more popular in our country. The tradition originated in Mexico where it is called a *posada*. Posada means Inn.
