

Hi everyone -

I am really enjoying the discipline of 'Thy Kingdom Come' this year and can hardly believe it's been going for 10 years as an international initiative. For those of you who haven't come across it - it's an annual event from Ascension Day to Pentecost where we are invited to select five people who we would like to know Jesus better. The idea that each day of the 10 days we pray for these five people (of course if we feel we can go on after Pentecost that's good too).

What we pray for those five people is the words 'Thy Kingdom Come.' In other words, we ask that God will make known to those five people how much they are loved, cared for and held in the love of God.

How that happens in the lives of each of the people on that list is God's work. It may be that an opportunity will arise for us to enter into conversation, but it may well be that something else will happen.

Imagine what would happen if each of us intentionally and persistently prayed for five people each. How many hundreds of people would that involve?

To help with 'Thy Kingdom Come' there is a really helpful booklet - a Novena - written by the Archbishop of York - there are copies in all of the Circuit Churches - please do take one and work through the ten days of meditations and prayers - I'm finding that particularly helpful this year.

And please don't worry if you're feeling like you've missed the boat. There's no reason why you can't start this coming Sunday - the day of Pentecost - to start your 10 days of prayer.

Who knows what might happen.






