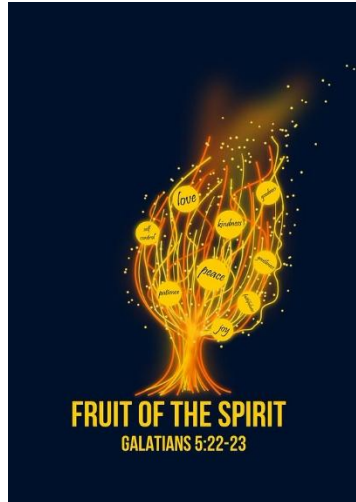


## Wey Valley Circuit Prayer Diary May 2026 – Part II



**Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> 7<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter-** Pray for the Worship, Ministry and Mission at Cranleigh 10.30am, Stoughton 10.30am, Weybridge 10.30am.

As Pentecost approaches with the gift of the Holy Spirit, take time to reflect on our mission through the 'Fruits of the Spirit'...

**Monday 18<sup>th</sup> LOVE – Holy Spirit:** Empower me to love with all my heart and hands, to hold those who are hurting. Let my love be real, in giving and receiving; As you love me, help me to love others, with no demands, just open hands and a loving, caring, praying heart. *(from StF 615 v 1)*

**Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> JOY – Holy Spirit:** Fill me with joy in following Jesus all the way; every day! His love is like a rainbow when earthly skies are grey; Joy, joy wonderful joy, nothing can destroy. With joy so boundless and free this, my Lord, gives to me to share, eagerly, with all I meet. *(adapted from Salvation Army Chorus Book 184, 206)*

**Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> PEACE – Holy Spirit:** Make me a channel of your peace; where there is hatred, let me bring your love, where there's despair in life, let me bring hope. Grant that I may never seek, so much to be consoled as to console, to be loved as to love with all my soul. *(adapted from StF 707)*

**Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> PATIENCE – Holy Spirit:** Give me the ability to persevere in loving, serving and sharing your love, despite adversity, difficulty, or opposition; so that your love and light will shine into the darkest places. *{Adapted from Merriam Webster Dictionary}*

**Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> Pray** for the [Street Angels](#) in Woking, Guildford and elsewhere that the love, light, power and hope of Abba Father, Son and Holy Spirit will shine through them and bless their commitment to serve. Give them strength and security at this sometimes, difficult time. Amen.

**Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> Pray** for the ministry and mission of the Coffee Morning at Knaphill 10.00am-12.00noon, and The Tear Fund Quiz at Walton on Thames 2.00pm-4.00pm

**Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> Pentecost - Pray** for the Worship, Ministry and Mission at Godalming 10.30am, West Horsley 10.00am - and all who participate in worship across the Circuit.

**Aldersgate Day: Holy Spirit:** Empower me, as you did with John and Charles Wesley. Give me the faith which can remove and sink the mountain to a plain, give me the childlike, praying love which longs to build your house again; your love, let it my heart o'erpower:

**Monday 25<sup>th</sup> KINDNESS: Holy Spirit:** Fill me with the loving kindness Jesus had for all who needed it. Help me to show that loving kindness to all those I meet and to reach out the helping hand to lift out those in sinking sand! Remembering that from sinking sand Jesus lifted me, with tender hand He lifted me. From shades of night to plains of light, I praise His name, Emanuel – He lifted me! *(Adapted from TMH 1954)*

**Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> GENEROSITY: Holy Spirit:** Fill me with the desire to share – your love and compassion in practical ways through generosity – giving as much as I can of my time, talents, energy and financial resources where they are needed, across the world. Remembering that what I have is a gift of your love and was intended to be shared in whatever way you ask. Teach me to be generous in my prayers.

**Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> FAITHFULNESS: Holy Spirit:** Help and support me to be faithful to your calling. To respond as Isaiah in faith – ‘Here am I, send me. Praying, let me work for peace; singing, sharing joy with all; working for a world that’s new, faithful when I hear your call. *(from StF 411)*

**Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> GENTLENESS: Holy Spirit:** Teach me to avoid quarrelling, show gentleness, understanding, courtesy, compassion and love to those with whom I don’t agree. *(Based on Titus 3:2)*

**Friday 30<sup>th</sup> SELF CONTROL: Holy Spirit:** Breath through the heat of my desires, your coolness and your balm; let sense be dumb, let flesh retire, speak through the earthquake, wind and fire, O still small voice of calm (From StF 495:6)

**Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> Pray** for the Circuit Local Arrangement training workshop at Woking Trinity 2.30pm – 4.30pm.

**Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> Trinity Sunday Pray** for the Worship, Ministry and Mission at Merrow 10.30am, and Walton-on-Thames at 10.00am.

**Reflect** on these ancient words - God, whose almighty word, chaos and darkness heard, and took their flight, hear me, I humbly pray and where the gospel day sheds not its glorious ray, let there be light!

Christ, you have come to bring on your redeeming wing healing and sight, health to the sick in mind, sight to the inly blind, O to all humankind let there be light!
